



Grand Bazaar: The oldest and the largest covered market place in the World with nearly 4.000 shops full of rich collections of carpets, jewellery, leather and souvenirs.

Topkapi Palace: The great palace of the Ottoman sultans from the 15th to the 19th centruies housing an exquisite collection of crystal, silver and Chinese porcelain, robes worn by the sultans and their families, the famous jewels of the Imperial Treasury, miniatures, the Holy Mantle; enshiring relics of the Probhet Mohammed.

Hagia Irene Church: Built during the same period (4th century) as its neighbour the Hagia Sophia. The name Hagia Irene Church means "Godly" or "Holy Wisdom" in Greek. After the conquest of Istanbul it was incorporated into the grounds of Topkapi Palace and like many other churches was converted into a mosque. However there were no major changes made to the building's structure.



Camlica Hill: The highest point in Istanbul. At the top of it you cannest and admite the magnificent panorama of Istanbul and the Bosphorus from the beautiful gardens, landscaped in traditional style.

Grand Camlica Mosque: Çamlıca Mosque has six minarets which represent the six articles of Islamic faith (iman). Four of the sixminarets feature three balconies that stand 107.1 metres high in recognition of the Seljuks' Victory at Manzikert in 1071. The other two minarets feature two balconies and are 90 metres high.

Beylerbeyi Palace: The summer residence of Ottoman Sultans with its original furniture and magnificent gardens with the Harem on the Asian.

City Walls: The first breach of the walls was by the Fourth Crusade in 1204, the second by the cannons and troops of Fatih Sultan Mehmet the Conqueror in 1453.

Cable Car: Cable car is an enjoyable experience to try and see the total view of Golden Horn.

Pierre Loti Hill: This hilltop offer you a spectacular view of Golden Horn. The hill takes its name from a famous French naval officer and novelist known for his exotic boks, especially one he based on his experiences in Istanbul.






Bursa was the first major and second overall capital of the Ottoman State between 1335 and 1363. Bursa has many architectural artifacts and ruins reflecting the Ottoman architecture. The city was referred to as Hudavendigar during the Ottoman period, while a more recent nickname is Yesil Bursa (Green Bursa) in reference to the parks and gardens located across its urban fabric,as well as tovast and richly varied forest of the surrounding region. Mount Uludag, known is classical antiquity as the Musical Olympos or alternatively Bithynian Olympus, towers over the city, and has a well-known ski resort.







Later we will take some photos from the nicest corners of Pamukkale. Free time for about 60 minutes to explore the natural beauties of Pamukkale. Then meet with the guide, start walking in the middle of travertines from up to down without shoes and socks. We will have lunch in a local restaurant. End of the tour, transfer to Ephesus. Free time and overnight.

DAY 4 - EPHESUS TOUR & FLY BACK TO ISTANBUL

Ephesus was also one of the Seven Churches of Anatolia (Asia) that are cited in the Book of Revelation. 
